# WHAT IS EMPLOYMENTWORKS?

**EmploymentWorks** is a national program funded by the Government of Canada & the Sinneave Family Foundation designed to support individuals who self-identify as autistic or having other disabilities to prepare for, get, and keep jobs, or pursue further education.

### IS EMPLOYMENTWORKS FOR YOU?

- . Ages 15 to 64
- Motivated to find a job.
- Struggling to find and keep a job.

- Self-identified as autistic and/or having other disabilities.
- Can commit to 60 hours of training.

\*An initial screening assessment will be conducted to ensure appropriateness of program.

**PROGRAMOVERVIEW** 

### 12 weeks

#### Phase 1: Preparing for Work | 60 hours of guided employment preparedness training.

- **30 hours** | structured learning: skill development, career exploration, social skills in the workplace.
- **30 hours** | applied structured learning: participate in job sampling in community workplace settings.

#### 3 to 6 months

Phase 2: Getting Work | Support in actively participating in the labour market and getting jobs.

- Job search assistance, preparing resumes, applying for suitable job opportunities, developing effective interview skills.
- Support may also include
  assistance in pursuing additional
  educational opportunities.

#### Up to 1 year

Phase 3: Keeping Work | Onthe-job support based on individual needs.

- Job coaching, tools, and equipment.
- Wage subsidies to support subsidized work experience placement opportunities.
- Continued job searching supports.
