**EmploymentWorks** is a national program funded by the Government of Canada & the Sinneave Family Foundation designed to support individuals who self-identify as autistic or having other disabilities to prepare for, get, and keep jobs.

This **condensed summer course** has been specially designed for high school students who are in school, just out of school, or are interested in completing the program over a shorter period of time.

## IS SUMMER EMPLOYMENTWORKS FOR YOU?

- Over the age of 15.
- Self-identified as **autistic and/or having other disabilities**.
- **Motivated to find a job.**
- **Able to commit to a schedule of 4 weeks, 5 days per week, 3 hours per day.**

\*An initial screening assessment will be conducted to ensure appropriateness of program.

## PROGRAM AT A GLANCE JULY 2 TO 26, 2024

**EmploymentWorks** summer program is condensed and allows you to complete the **3-month** in-class learning and job sampling portion of the program in just **4 weeks**. After you finish the 4 weeks, you will be able to **get support with ongoing job search and job coaching until July 1, 2025**.
