

WHAT IS SUMMER EMPLOYMENTWORKS?

EmploymentWorks is a national program funded by the Government of Canada & the Sinneave Family Foundation designed to support individuals who self-identify as autistic or having other disabilities to prepare for, get, and keep jobs.

This **condensed summer course** has been specially designed for high school students who are in school, just out of school, or are interested in completing the program over a shorter period of time.

IS SUMMER EMPLOYMENTWORKS FOR YOU?

- Over the age of **15**.
- Self-identified as autistic and/or having other disabilities.
- Motivated to find a job.
- Able to commit to a schedule of 4 weeks, 5 days per week, 3 hours per day.

*An initial screening assessment will be conducted to ensure appropriateness of program.

EmploymentWorks summer program is condensed and allows you to complete the 3-month in-class learning and job sampling portion of the program in just 4 weeks. After you finish the 4 weeks, you will be able to get support with ongoing job search and job coaching until July 1, 2025.
