# Sexuality Matters - Teaching Privacy, Consent and Boundaries at Any Age 

The goal of this information session is to help develop the comfort, knowledge and practical skills needed for parents and caregivers to address areas of sexual health with their child. These areas may include development and puberty, hygiene, privacy, personal boundaries, relationships, consent and many more. This presentation is suitable for caregivers of children and youth with any physical, intellectual, or developmental disability.

## Supporting Social Communication Skills Through a Neurodiversity Affirming Lens

Social communication is the ability to use language and non-verbal communication with others. Social interaction involves many skills such as language skills, executive functioning skills, self-regulation, and the ability to understand different perspectives. This presentation will provide an overview of the building blocks of social communication, an introduction to understanding social skills through a neurodiversity affirming lens, and strategies for parents and family members to support their children with community engagement and developing positive social relationships.
